Parking for Clowns

Park wherever it is convenient for you. Parade route access pass is included. Share with security that you are a member of the DCC to pass through any street closures.

New Security Measure at the building

The doors will be locked, there will be a sign on the door that says Closed, call security 419-345-1355 for entry. Let security know you are with the clown corp and they will let you in.

Candy Clowns: You will be provided with candy bags as you exit out of the back of the former Edison building. Please stop by the red truck to have your candy bag filled with one more bag of candy. There are three candy stop locations along the parade route. Volunteers will be on site to assist with candy refill. The refill stations are blue Blade trucks, and they are located at Summit & Jackson Blvd, Huron & Adams and Huron & Jefferson.

Clown Breakfast: As a courtesy to all the clowns, the clown breakfast is <u>reserved for clowns only</u>. There will be pastries and beverages in the lobby provided by Focaccia's for your kids and family. The same pastries in the lobby are offered to the volunteers and the Toledo School for the Arts students.

VIP Seating

VIP seating passes for your family members will be available at the former Edison Security Guard desk located in the lobby. The VIP seating area is in front of Imagination Station, passes are needed, and it is designated as an orange square on the parade map.

Upon completion of the parade, please return your clown suit, name badge, bells and candy sacks items to the 8th floor of former Edison Bldg. Please put your items back in your named garment bag and be certain your badge is on your suit. If you need repairs to your suit, please contact Allison Hammons.
